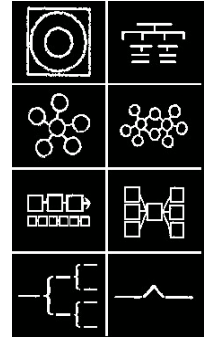


Thinking Maps[®] Software

Frequently Asked Questions



Q: *What is a community license? Are there any other licenses available for purchase?*

A: A community license allows your school to use the Software on all computers on the school's premises and make copies for student and teacher use at their respective residences. Thinking Maps, Inc. also plans on releasing an individual license, which will authorize the purchaser to install and use the Software on one computer at a single location.

Q: *Can you import images into Thinking Maps Software 2.0?*

A: Thinking Maps Software 2.0 allows the user to import images into the maps. To import an image into a map, simply click the Fill icon on the Formatting Toolbar and select "Fill with Image." You will be prompted to select a TM 2.0 Compatible image (jpg,jpeg,bmp,gif,png,tif,tiff,ico,pcx).

Q: *Can you export maps into third party applications?*

A: Thinking Maps Software 2.0 allows users to easily export maps into third party applications. To export a map into a third party application, click "Export" on the File menu and save your map in a JPEG or PNG file format. Next, open the target application and insert the Thinking Maps as a picture. This feature is disabled on the demonstration version of the software.

Q: *Can you install Thinking Maps Software 2.0 on the network or school server?*

A: It is recommended that Thinking Maps Software 2.0 be installed on each individual workstation. While files may be stored and shared through a server, users should not endeavor to run the application from a server for multiple workstations.
